Morning Services 10am

Everyone gathers in the church for the service starting at 10am. We encourage primary age children to sit towards the front of the church. The service follows a fairly traditional format with worship items, prayers, children's talk & song, bible reading and sermon. The first part of the service will include something specific for the young people who will then leave for their activities and re-join us in the church before the end of the service. Tea and Coffee is served in the hall after the service.

In St Blane's the preaching is of an expository style where we systematically work our way through books of the bible. We encourage each other to take God's word seriously and open it together. We also recognise the benefits of our AV system which will be used to help us understand what the passage we are looking at means about God and for us.

Please note the Minister will be at the door of the church after the service for a short time before heading off to our linked congregation to take the service at 11.30pm. People are always warmly encouraged to contact Gary directly if they need to speak to him (01786 825324).

St Blane's is a family friendly congregation where all ages are welcomed. Families welcome each other together in their homes making allowances for all ages so we believe Church should be no different. Therefore we want everyone to be as comfortable as possible during worship, so please do not worry if your young one makes a noise during the service (we all understand). We also recognise and fully understand that families visiting for the first time may want their young people to sit with them during the service.

A crèche is always available and families are welcome to use it during the services. Again we also recognise that some people may not be comfortable with using the crèche at first so may want to keep their children with them for the whole service. Please feel free to do that.
